

Green Bookings System

Although we all want to get back to 'normal' as soon as possible, it is becoming increasingly clear that things might not return to the way they were before the virus for a very long time.

To comply with Government guidance on re-opening your bowling green it is important that you have an off-site, and preferably electronic system for allocating games and keeping records of green use. This presents a major logistical challenge to most clubs as there will need to be a system for allocating green use in a fair and preferably hands off way.

There will also be a need to maintain an on-going record of attendance at the green for the foreseeable future in order to comply with any future track and trace requests.

Most importantly, clubs will have to try to meet this new list of requirements in a way that has a minimum requirement for labour and of course that is cost effective.

Booking Process

Bookings MUST be made via the club's web-site and, initially, will be restricted to 1 session of **1 ½ hours** per day. **All members planning to attend the new Sunday & Wednesday 'formal' roll-ups should also register their attendance at these sessions.**

- Open Witham Bowls Club in your browser → <http://www.withambowlsclub.org/>
- Click on "Witham Bowls Club: Google Calendar" button. This will allow you to identify available 'slots' from which you can choose. You **CANNOT** input yourself.
- Return to the WBC website and select the "contact us" menu option and input your request together with any additional player(s) – maximum **6** players *in total* per rink unless they are from the SAME HOUSEHOLD
- This will then send your request to the WBC COVID-19 Sub Committee who will create the event on the WBC Calendar which automatically sends a confirmation email to all members quoted on the request
- Your booking will appear on the Google Calendar for all to see – Please check that it is correct.

We endeavour to update the calendar promptly but we can't guarantee an immediate response as this latter part is entered manually.
